Talk about what happens at each of these times. (Remember days and months should have a capital letter)</p>	<p>Can you write some sentences to tell us what you have been doing over the weekend? Try to use 'and' / 'because' / 'so', to join two sentences together. Make sure that your capital letter are the right size.</p>
<p>Think about the five senses (hear, touch, see, smell, taste) What have you sensed today? What was it like?</p>	<p>Valentine's day happens at the end of this half term (14th Feb) Can you make a card for someone you love and write in it why you love them.</p>
<p>Use the sound sheet/ cards you had before Christmas to practice reading and spelling words with the different digraphs. Write some of the words you practice in this book.(If you need a new sheet please ask us!)</p>	<p>Can you count in twos, fives and tens up to 50? Notice and talk about the patterns. Try forwards and backwards for an extra challenge. Write the numbers in your book - be sure they are the right way round!</p>
