Dear Parents/Carers,

As most of you will be aware, the school was inspected by OFSTED in both January and July. Due to new OFSTED procedures in a revised framework they revisited the school in July 18. As you will appreciate this is a very short timescale in which to make a significant impact. Whilst Ofsted in July recognised that much progress was evident they judged the school to be requiring improvement overall, stating that there had been insufficient time to embed new processes.

We were very disappointed in the outcome and want to assure you that everything in the report is, and was, already part of our school improvement plan moving forward.

The implementation of our Talk for Writing strategy and the use of the White Rose strategy for Maths has had a huge impact on our outcomes across the whole school this year. We now need to continue to improve our progress levels to ensure they are consistently good. Our current in-year data shows a positive trend moving forward. This year our progress for year 6 pupils has improved significantly in reading and mathematics.

What happens now?

At this point we are working extremely hard to address the issues identified and are confident we will move back to a 'Good' rating.

We will be working very closely with you, the Governors, the Local Authority and our Teaching School Alliance to ensure we continue to strive for excellence so that our pupils are getting the highest quality education that they can.
