Useful conversations to have at home:

Encourage discussion about how they are the same/different to their friends, peers at school/clubs and reinforce the idea that differences should be respected and celebrated.



Watch films such as Mulan or Brave which challenge gender stereotypes and encourage them to follow their interests and likes/dislikes regardless of any gender stereotypes.
