British Values: democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs.

We Are Learning to:

Recognise the importance of self-respect and how to respect others.

Recognise behaviours/actions which discriminate against others.

Respect and recognise the differences and similarities between people.

Identify what contributes to who we are.

Debate topical issues, respecting other people's points of view/constructively challenging those they disagree with.

Recognise their individuality and personal qualities.

Understand and challenge stereotypes.

Useful conversations to have at home:



- Encourage discussion about how they are the same/different to their friends, peers at school/clubs and reinforce the idea that differences should be respected and celebrated.
- Watch films such as Mulan or Brave which challenge gender stereotypes and encourage them to follow their interests and likes/dislikes regardless of any gender stereotypes.
- Discuss the British Values:
-respect and tolerance
-individual liberty.
