CHANGE POLICY

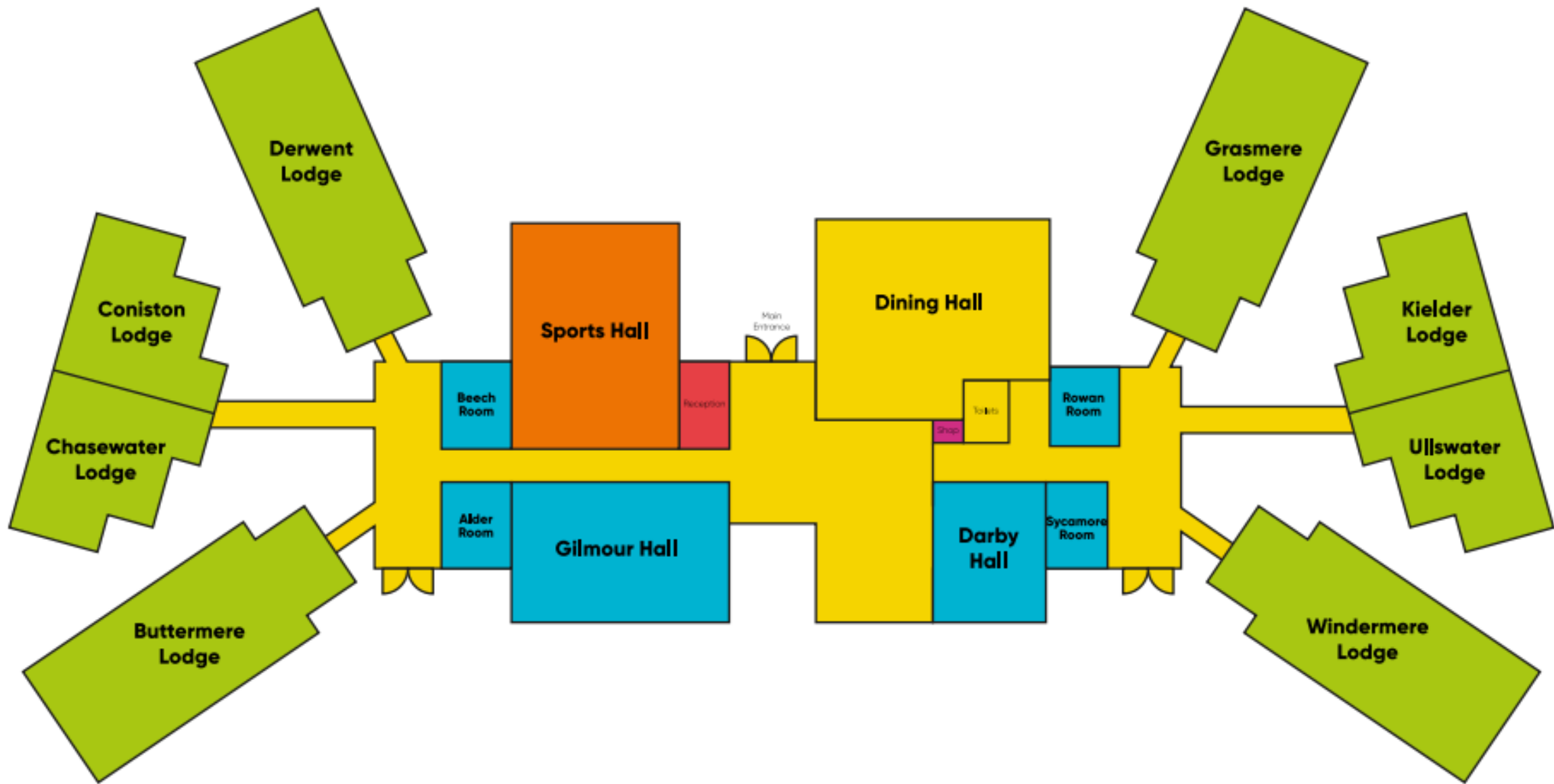

Activities

We will be completing SUP (Stand Up Paddleboarding) and Kayaking. This means the children need to bring **two extra sets** of clothes and shoes that they don't mind getting wet. They also need to make sure that they bring **2 black bin bags** to put these in after, plus an **extra towel**.

The equipment list gives you an idea of what to bring.

Clothes – make sure these are suitable to get wet/dirty, and you are not worried about them being damaged.



Essential:

Water bottle – bottle of squash if they would like

Up to **one** bag of sweets/chocolate/share bag of crisps (please make sure none of them contain nuts)

Inhaler – labelled (This needs to be kept with them)

Waterproof coat

Suitable footwear one/two for wet activity one to wear for the rest of the time, one pair for inside too (this can be slippers)

Small bag – to carry water bottle, sun cream, inhaler etc

Hair bobbles (Hair needs to be tied for activities)

No earrings

Sun cream

Sun hat

T - shirts – covering shoulders (no strappy tops or vest tops)

Please see the list for other items

What not to bring:

Aerosols (deodorant or body spray) – these set off the fire alarms (roll on deodorant is fine)

Mobile phones

Tablets/consoles/straighteners (any electrical items – BUT you may bring a hair dryer)

Jewellery

Crop tops – you may not be able to take part in activities due to safety

Jeans

Fizzy drinks

Expensive watches

Behaviour

High standards of behaviour are required at all times at Whitemoor Lakes but especially during activities and at night times.

All staff (school staff and centre staff) have the right to exclude children from activities where their behaviour is felt to endanger themselves or others.

The staff at Whitemoor Lakes and staff from Stenson Fields also have the right to ask children to be returned home if their behaviour is unacceptable.

Parents will be made aware and have to pick their child up.

No refunds will be given.

Monday 1st June:

We will have two arrival times on this day – 8.50am or 10.40am. You will receive a form to indicate what time your child will be arriving.

Wednesday 3rd June:

Your child **can** be picked up once we return to school. This should be around 2.30pm. If they are not collected by 3.15pm, they will be dismissed as usual to walk home or go to After-School Club.

If another parent is picking your child up, please make sure that we have this in writing.

Thursday 4th June:

Your child is not expected to arrive in school until 10am. However, if they need to arrive at 8.50am, they can. Again, you will receive a form to indicate what time your child will be arriving.
