Dear Parents and Carers,

We have a busy year ahead of us in Dolphin and Zebra classes and would like to share some key information with you. One of our main focuses in Year 6 is getting the children 'Secondary School ready' by making them more independent and responsible. Please ensure your child has a **named water bottle with them every day**.

PE sessions:

They will come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days.

PE sessions will be both indoors and outdoors but ensure that they have a warm tracksuit for the colder weather.

Homework:

Homework will generally be handed out on a Friday and is due in the following Wednesday. Throughout the year, extra tasks may be set.

We expect the children to read **regularly** for sustained periods of time (at least 15 minutes).
