Expressive Arts and Design	Weekly taught skills session and then ongoing through Continuous Provision Role play linked to topic changes half termly. ‘Home corner’ role play all year. Art: explore drawing, painting, printing, collage, textiles and 3D art through learning choices. Develop confidence and competence using a range of tools, materials and techniques. Music: pulse and steady beat, tempo (faster/slower), dynamics (loud/quiet), pitch (high/low), singing voices and attentive listening. Developed through singing games, movement, listening, individual/group singing and musical play. Aurora classroom music online and singing games and Rhymes book.
